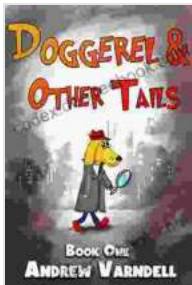

In "A Dog's Memory," Edna St. Vincent Millay writes:

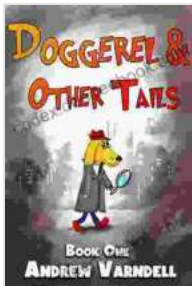

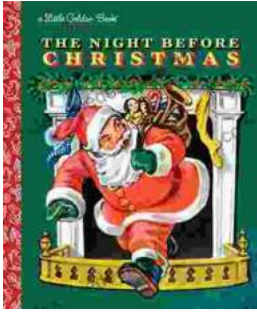

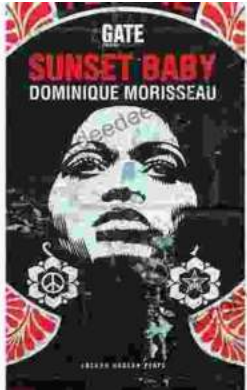
