Row 11:

Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). Then, double crochet into the next stitch. Now, decrease by working 2 double crochets together. Continue decreasing by working 2 double crochets together around the round until you have 12 double crochets remaining. Join the round with a slip stitch into the first double crochet.



Row 12:

Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). Then, double crochet into the next stitch. Now, decrease by working 2 double crochets together. Continue decreasing by working 2 double crochets together around the round until you have 6 double crochets remaining. Join the round with a slip stitch into the first double crochet.



Row 13:

Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). Then, double crochet into the next 3 stitches. Now, decrease by working 2 double crochets together around the round until you have 3 double crochets remaining. Join the round with a slip stitch into the first double crochet.



Row 14:

Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). Then, double crochet into the next stitch. Now, decrease by working 2 double crochets together around the round until you have 2 double crochets remaining. Join the round with a slip stitch into the first double crochet.



Row 15:

Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). Then, double crochet into the next stitch. Now, decrease by working 2 double crochets together. Fasten off the yarn and pull through the last loop to close the hat.



Finishing Touches:

Weave in any loose ends using a yarn needle. Optionally, you can add a decorative element, such as a flower or ribbon, to the side of the hat for a touch of personalized flair.
