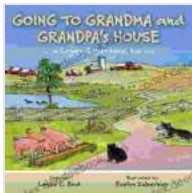


Going to Grandma and Grandpa's House: Logan's Adventure to Remember

As the sun began to set, casting a golden glow over the garden, it was time for dinner. Grandma had prepared Logan's favorite meal - spaghetti with

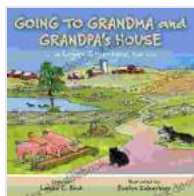
meatballs and freshly baked garlic bread. Logan ate with gusto, savoring each delicious bite while chatting animatedly with his grandparents.

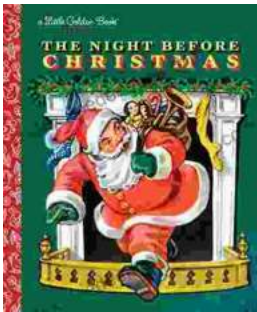

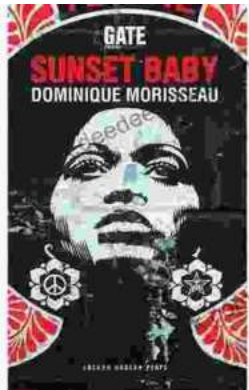
