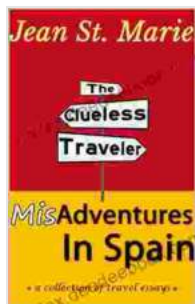


Misadventures in Spain: A Collection of Travel Essays

I went to see a doctor, and he told me that I had food poisoning. He said that I had probably eaten something that was contaminated with bacteria.

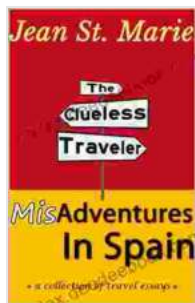
I was so relieved to know that I was not going to die, but I was still very angry. I had been so looking forward to my trip to Madrid, and now it had been ruined by food poisoning.

I would definitely recommend visiting Spain to anyone who is looking for an adventure. Just be sure to be prepared for anything.



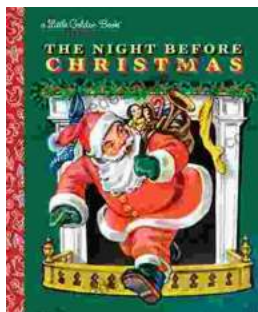
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
