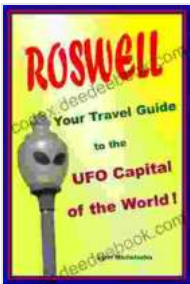

Things to Do in Roswell

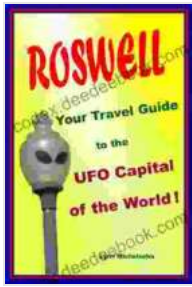
In addition to visiting UFO-related attractions, there are a number of other things to do in Roswell. These include:

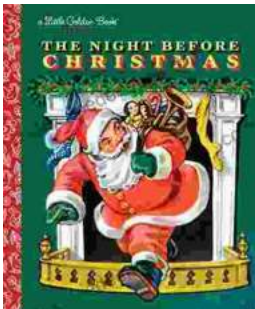
